Safety Information

Please carefully read the following information regarding safety:

-  Place on a flat, even surface.
-  Ensure the surface is capable of holding the weight of the full percolator.
-  Do not open the lid while the coffee is brewing.
-  Do not touch any surface of the percolator when the coffee is brewing.
-  Do not immerse the unit in water.
-  Not suitable for outdoor use.


General Description

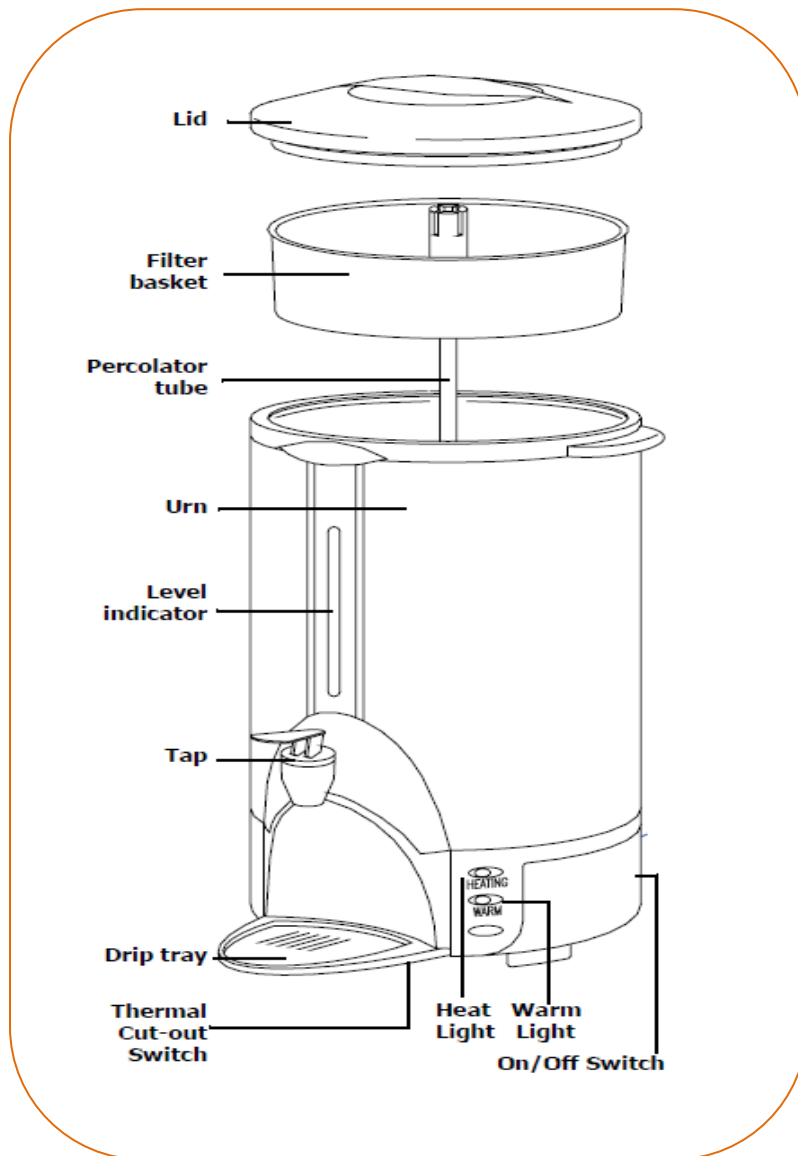
Oxford Event Hire's Coffee Percolator is ideal for serving hot coffee for up to 75 guests. We would specifically recommend it for a speedy, efficient serving at your event.

Starting up

Connect the cabinet to main power.

- Pour fresh, cold water into the urn; filling it at least half way (use the water measure on the front for reference) and no further than 'max'.
- Insert the percolator tube into the urn with the large head at the bottom.
- Slot the filter basket over the percolator tube. Fill the basket with the desired amount of coffee.
- Place the lid on the coffee percolator. Twist to lock into place.
- Connect to power supply and press 'ON' switch. The 'HEAT' light illuminates.
- The 'WARM' light illuminates when the coffee is brewed. The percolator keeps the coffee at serving temperature.
- Turn the power off when the measure filter is almost empty to avoid damage to the heating element.

 Please note: The lid of the appliance becomes very hot during use. Do not touch!



Thermal Cut-Out Reset

This appliance is fitted with a Thermal Cut-Out safety feature. Should the temperature exceed safe levels, the appliance will automatically cut power.

The Safety Cut-out switch is located on the underside of the appliance. To reset the appliance, do as follows:

- Empty the appliance and allow to cool.
- Press the reset button until it clicks.

Serving

- Place a suitable container under the tap.
- Pull the tap towards you to begin pouring coffee.
- Lift the tap back up to stop the flow of coffee.

Packing Down

When you have finished with your Coffee Percolator, please do the following:

- Switch off, unplug and allow the display to cool down.
- Please remove all contents, for example, all coffee grains and liquids.
